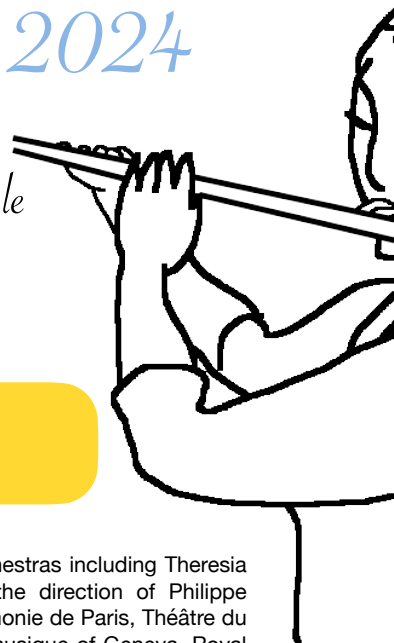

Anne is a keen flautist playing modern and historical flutes. She specialised alongside orchestras including Theresia Orchestra, Dunedin Consort, London Handel, Britten-Pears baroque orchestra under the direction of Philippe Herreweghe, Christophe Coin, Jordi Savall, John Butt, and others at Wigmore Hall, Philharmonie de Paris, Théâtre du Châtelet, Victoria Hall. Anne studied at Royal Conservatoire of Brussels, Haute École de musique of Geneva, Royal Academy of Music of London, and Royal Conservatoire of Liege. She has MA degrees in modern and historical flutes with distinction and highest distinction.

Possibility to discover and play the renaissance flutes (440Hz)

## Repertoire

Highlight on oral tradition & music ensemble

- Flute sessions (indiv./exchange/active listening):

The sessions will not require any music sheet but will tend to work from oral tradition.

Different aspects of the flute playing/technique will be discussed and practiced by imitation, repetition and improvisation.

Nevertheless, the participants are welcome to bring some music they want to work on.

- Flute ensemble sessions:

Renaissance song (instrumental versions), instr. dances (renaissance, baroque, modern, folk)

The music will be practiced and taught in the oral tradition.

Listeners are welcome. The daily fee is £20.
